Reason # 7

Tithing Expresses Our Love

God wants us as His redeemed children to give from loving hearts. "Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver" (2 Corinthians 9:7). However, Old Testament Law taught that, even without a loving heart, the people were obligated under the Law to tithe. In addition to the required



giving, they were also encouraged to give freewill offerings. Whether given grudgingly or cheerfully, the tithe was to be given, whereas offerings were to be given from loving and cheerful hearts.

Under the New Covenant, we are no longer required to give under the Law, but God still desires us to give. For Christians, giving has never been an option. Prompted by love for the One Who loved us so much that He Himself was willing to be obedient, even obedient to death on a Cross, we joyfully exercise our opportunity to give. Because Jesus has reconciled us through His blood and freed us from bondage to sin, we now give with the freedom Jesus has won for us. By grace, we are given a wonderful privilege to give first and foremost out of love rather than out of duty. Although our duty to give still exists, it is overshadowed by our desire to give. Love displaces duty as our primary motivator to be obedient and to give joyfully and generously.

As beneficiaries of God's great love and tremendous sacrifice, we are empowered to share His love with others. Because we are forgiven and redeemed people, we are compelled to give. "For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: that One has died for all, therefore all have died; and He died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for Him Who for their sake died and was raised" (2 Corinthians 5:14-15).

Prayer: Dear Jesus, thank You for loving me so much that You bore the cross with joy (Hebrews 12:2) so that I might live as a forgiven and saved person. Help me to show my love in thoughts and deeds, especially in my giving. In Your name I pray. Amen.

Dear Crusader for His Kingdom,

God's Grace and Peace to you from the Central Illinois District Church Extension Fund!

Through its Growth Bond Program, the Central Illinois District Church Extension Fund (CID-CEF) has encouraged the young members of our congregations to save up their treasures while supporting the growth of the LCMS and God's Kingdom in the Central Illinois District. Many of our youth have taken advantage of this program, but the time has now come to bring the program to an end.

The CID-CEF will initiate the following steps to bring the Growth Bond Program to a close:

- All unused stamps not yet in booklets will be refunded at stamp face value upon presentation.
- All stamps in booklets, partial or full, will be refunded at stamp face value upon presentation.
- Growth Bonds that have not yet reached maturity will be allowed to reach maturity value. At that time, the Growth Bond will be redeemed, or the owner may have the option to reinvest in a CID-CEF Flexible Savings Account or Investment Certificate where qualified and permissible to do so.
- Growth Bonds that have matured will, after a 60-day notification period, be redeemed at their current value, or the owner may have the option to reinvest in a CID-CEF Flexible Savings Account or Investment Certificate where qualified and permissible to do so.

Please submit all unused stamps and stamps in booklets to us for redemption by December 31, 2021. We ask churches and schools to please communicate this request as necessary to members of their congregations and schools.

Communications regarding redemption of Growth Bonds already purchased will be sent 60 days in advance of their maturity or redemption as a reminder of this change and to allow reinvestment, where qualified and permissible to do so.

We thank you for participating in the Growth Bond program and pray that you have likewise grown spiritually from the knowledge that you have assisted with reaching souls by providing the use of your treasures to build and grow our churches and schools in the Central Illinois District.

May God's guidance and blessings be with you as you continue on life's journey as His Crusader!
